INFORMATION

We are open from 7.30am to 5.30pm. The half day programme runs from 9.00am to 3.30pm.

The cost of any trips and activities are included in the price.

We endeavour to make the programme as flexible as possible to suit your needs as parents.

Half Day Programme \$22.00 per day (9.00am – 3.30pm) and extra hours charged at minimum rate of \$3.50 per hour

WINZ applicants will be charged the current WINZ subsidy rates

FEES:

Payment is required in advance of the programme. Please check to make sure a placement is available before payment is made (your place will be held for one working day) Once payment is received this will confirm your child/rens place in the Holiday Programme. Receipts can be collected at the end of each week and payments are tax deductible. REFUNDS will only be given if 5 working days notice is received in writing and will incur a \$5.00 withdrawal fee per child, per day to cover administration costs. If paying by cash – correct payment is required as we can not give change. Cheque payments made out to Kids Domain. If you are applying for a WINZ subsidy please complete all forms required and attach relevant documentation and hand into the supervisor for processing – no enrolments will be accepted without your WINZ subsidy forms. WINZ forms are not to be handed in any later than one week before holidays commence.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS:

Please ensure all medication is collected and recorded by the supervisor and signed by a parent/caregiver. Your child will be required to bring lunch, snacks and a water bottle unless specified. Days activities may change unexpectedly, please ensure your child has appropriate clothing for outdoor activities e.g wet weather gear – umbrellas, jackets, warm/cool clothing. Skirts/good clothing are not always appropriate. It is the parents responsibility to make sure your child has sunhat and sun protection for those sunny days. I understand that I may be contacted to collect my child at the supervisors discretion. I understand that staff will be free and clear of all liability in the event that any injury, damage or loss is sustained by my child or to personal affects. Children are welcome to bring in toys, games etc – but it is their responsibility to take care of their equipment. I understand that I will be liable for any costs if willful damage to property occurs. If you are late to pick up your child from the programme a \$20.00 penalty fee will apply for the first 15 minutes, then \$20.00 per every 5 minutes after that.
